CIAA hosts AVSEC Managers Course

Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands (7 July, 2016) The Cayman Islands Airports Authority (CIAA) has successfully facilitated an International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) Aviation Security (AVSEC) Managers course at the Owen Roberts International Airport.

This is the first time that an ICAO Managers course has been held in the overseas territories. Nine participants, including five CIAA staff members successfully completed the ten day course which is a regulatory requirement for all AVSEC managers.

Participants were trained by instructor Neil Coull on a wide variety of topics including ICAO's standard and recommended practices, quality control and threats as well as risks and contingency planning.

ICAO is a United Nations specialized agency that was created to manage the administration and governance of the Convention on International Civil Aviation.
