Subject: Airside Vehicle and Ground Handling Equipment Permits

It is the responsibility of all employers to ensure that relevant AOIs are brought to the attention of ALL their staff. However, individuals remain responsible for their own actions and those who are in any doubt should consult their Supervisor or Manager.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 This AOI is to inform all airport users of the requirements and general rules of operation to ensure a safe airside environment at Owen Roberts International Airport for both airside drivers, staff and passengers.

2. BACKGROUND

2.1 There has been a noticeable increase in ground handling service equipment having expired permits. With the advent of the re-opening of the borders and the increased aircraft movements all equipment are obliged to have the correct permits.

3. PURPOSE

3.1 All vehicles and ground handling equipment have a mandatory requirement to fulfil the requirements of the Airside Vehicle Operating Manual Chapter 7.

4. NOTIFICATION

4.1 **All organizations have 7 days (15th September) to obtain the correct permit or remove vehicles/equipment from airside.**

4.2 Vehicles or equipment that do not have the correct valid permit after 15th September will be required to be removed from airside on the instruction of the CIAA Operations team
