QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

These competencies are necessary to assist the Trainee to assimilate and develop intricate theoretical & practical knowledge and experience to function efficiently in a safety critical, technically complex professional environment.

The successful applicant initially assumes the role of 'Trainee' that, while undergoing training in the practical application of CNS Engineering procedures, he/she will assist the team of CNS Specialists as part of



the educational process, with the aim to prepare him/her to become a certified Aviation Electronics Engineer in the CIAA's Communications, Navigation & Surveillance Department

Salary and benefits: Salary range for Trainees' is between CI\$19,220.00 - \$ 36,767.00 per annum (plus the cost of part-time or full-time training) and will increase significantly upon completion of training and transition from a Trainee to a licensed or certified Electronic Engineering Officer. The exact entry Point along this Range will be commensurate with experience, qualifications, and other relevant attributes of the successful applicant.

Benefits include: all-expenses- paid training, with some components likely being overseas, a contributory pension plan, 12 days' paid vacation p.a. (while a Trainee) and fully paid health insurance for the employee.
