RESTRICTION OF ENTRY OF TRAVELLERS TO THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

1. RESTRICTION OF TRAVELLERS TO THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

Due to the current outbreak of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), the Cabinet of the Cayman Islands has issued regulations to control the entry of persons to the Cayman Islands from high risk areas under the Public Health Law (2002 Revision).

In line with global standards, effective March 16, 2020 until May 15, 2020, visitors from the following countries will be denied entry to the Cayman Islands:

- All countries in the Schengen area
- China
- Iran
- Japan
- South Korea

Returning residents and Caymanians who have travelled to the areas listed above and have symptoms consistent with COVID-19 will be quarantined at home under the direction of the Medical Officer of Health.

2. PUBLIC HEALTH ADVICE

Public health officials are reminding arriving passengers, if they have symptoms consistent with any respiratory illness, to seek medical attention and share their travel history with their healthcare provider, even if arriving from countries which have little or no instances of coronavirus at this time.

Common symptoms of the COVID-19 infection include: shortness of breath and flu-like symptoms such as cough or fever.
