

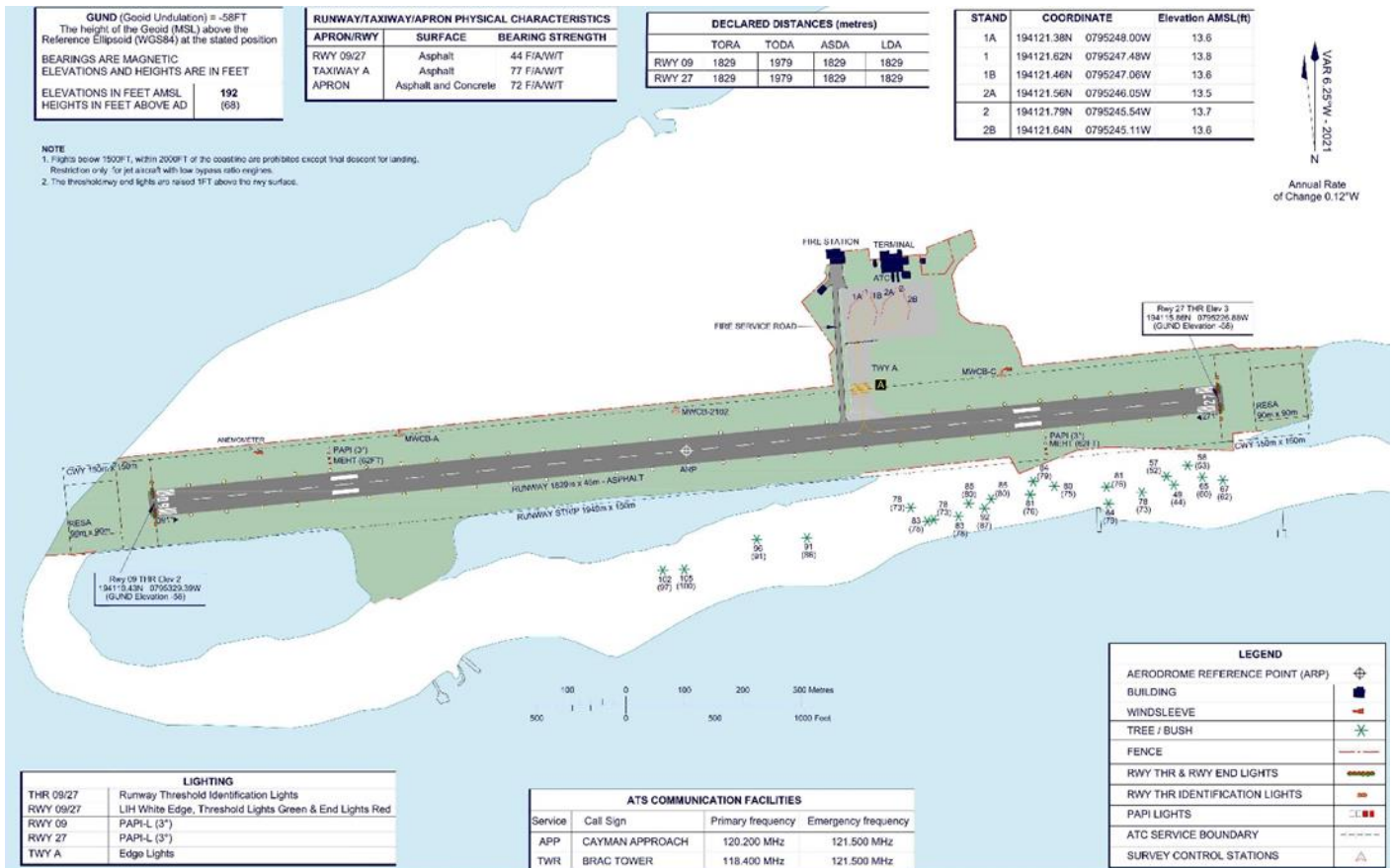

## Charles Kirkconnell International Airport Rescue Fire Fighting Service (RFFS) Access Road

### 1. Introduction

This Aeronautical Information Circular serves to notify aircraft operators of the implementation of a paved RFFS vehicle access road. This road is constructed west of apron and taxiway A. The road has a painted closed taxiway marking and is intended to be used exclusively for RFFS vehicles. The chart below displays the location of Rescue Fire Fighting Service access road.
