## Owen Roberts International Airport (MWCR) Cruise Ship Glass Pod

### 1. Introduction

1.1 A cruise ship attraction involving use of a glass enclosed pod attached to a mechanical arm lifting the pod up and down and over the side of the ship will occur northwest of Owen Roberts International Airport while anchored in George Town harbour at either of the below geographical locations at a maximum height of 98 metres (322 feet) above mean sea level.
